Qualifications and Experience	<ul> <li>Eligible applicants must:</li> <li>Have a university degree or diploma (QQ1 level 8 equivalent) obtained with 1st or 2nd class honours in which Psychology was taken as a major subject and honours obtained in that subject</li> <li>And</li> <li>Have an Irish post-graduate professional psychology qualification accredited by the Psychological Society of Ireland in Clinical, Counselling or Educational Psychology</li> <li>Or</li> <li>An equivalent qualification from another jurisdiction validated by the Department of Health.</li> <li>And</li> <li>Demonstrate competence in the Care Group/s applied for.</li> <li>And</li> <li>Applicants must have at least five years satisfactory post-graduate experience in the area of professional psychology, no more than three years of which was spent in gaining the postgraduate professional qualification and no less than two years full-time spent in post qualification experience as a professional psychologist.
