Foundations in AT Course

Enable Ireland's National AT Training Service offers annually the **James Brosnan Scholarship**, in memory of a man who was an expert AT user, journalist, powerful advocate, artist, Liverpool fan and all-round renaissance man. James followed his own path in terms of his use of technology, and he generously shared his extraordinary experience with others. His legacy is immense and can be seen [HERE](#) in a video that charts just a fraction of his life story, through the lens of Assistive Technology.

This scholarship will enable the successful applicant to register for Enable Ireland's Foundations in Assistive Technology course, accredited by Technological University, Dublin (TU Dublin), **free of charge**. This course is a Level 6 course, with 5 ECTS (European Credit Transfers). The standard course fee is €950. For further information, please see **Foundations in AT Course 2027 information**.

The next course will start in January 2027. It consists of 11 live webinars, with an additional 79 hours of self-directed learning.

Who Can Apply?

This scholarship is open to Assistive Technology users or prospective users, who wish to upskill in this area, and who are also willing to share their learning with others, through peer mentoring. Applicants must be:

- 18 years or older
- Have a lived experience of disability
- Be committed to 100 hours of blended learning
- Be committed to submitting a project based on their learning

A strong internet connection is a pre-requisite for participation in the course. In addition, access to a laptop or a tablet with a minimum 9" screen is also essential.

As this is an online course, applicants should be confident using either a computer or tablet to access websites and participate in web-based learning activities like quizzes and forums. **Please see next page for application form →**
