Introduction

Leisure and gaming can sometimes be overlooked when considering the needs of an individual with a disability. However, it is an important part of a young person's development and helps enable social inclusion. For children, the benefits of play have been shown to build up imagination, promote social skills, advance physical development and develop problemsolving skills etc. Here we look at how we can make leisure time and gaming more inclusive to a wide range of abilities. There are now many options for accessible toys, game consoles and switch-adapted toys.

The information has been prepared by Enable Ireland's National Assistive Technology Service. The toys shown are not necessarily recommendations but simply a selection of items which may be of interest, particularly at times such as Christmas and birthdays, when presents are high on the list of priorities.

Apps for Tablets

Nowadays tablets have a wide range of apps, some specifically designed for special needs. Accessibility settings built into the operating systems of iOS and android now make them more accessible. Apps

ChooseIt! Maker 3

The ChooseIt! Maker 3 App contains cause and effect activities, literacy activities, sound lotto and matching activities, multiple choice activities, games, and quizzes. It includes three sample activities which demonstrate some of the many ways ChooseIt! Maker 3 can be used to create a variety of learning activities using symbols, pictures and sounds.

Hurdle Champion

Choose a character and take part in a hurdle race against the computer. Works with a single switch or by touching the screen. This game provides a motivating way to develop switch and timing skills.




New Age Kurling

Switch Interfaces

Below is a sample of few switch interfaces of which there are several. Some work either iOS or Android devices or both.



Tapio switch interface



With Tapio and an adaptive switch, a single switch user can have complete access to an iPad, an iPhone or an iPod touch, using Apple's Switch Control feature. A single switch scanner can move the highlight to an app on the home screen, launch it, and scan to controls within the app.

The Tapio comes with one of the following Apple Adapters - Lighting to USB, or USB type C to USB type A. Switch Control provides revolutionary access to Apple's iOS touch interface. Computer Games

There are a wide range of games available for the general PC. Games that require a high skill level in hand/eye coordination may not be accessible for many users. However, some mainstream games can be made more accessible with additional hardware or software as seen below in alternative input methods. Fortunately, many games have been designed to be more accessible to play such as One Switch games. There are several resources dedicated to accessible games that provide discussion forums and game reviews.

Alternative input methods

Before considering specialize software to access a computer, it's worth looking at alternative methods to access your computer. The standard method or input device to control a computer is your standard keyboard and mouse. If this is not suitable for the user, then there are a range of other options that can replace the standard keyboard and mouse.

Touch screens

Touch screens are becoming the norm in terms of mobile devices and computers. They can be used as an alternative option for mouse control. Additionally using an onscreen keyboard will allow text entry. Touch screens are available in a range of sized and can replace the standard computer screen on a desktop PC. They are available from most computer stores and may already be built into laptop or desktop screen.

Switch access programs

This type of software can enable switch control of the keyboard and mouse. Customised grids can be made to suit the user and application. Switches are used to activate a scan and select cells within the grid. Two common switch access programs include Grid 3 -

thinksmartbox.com and Communicator 5 - AAC

software - Tobii Dynavox Global. Both applications have similar features.



In order to use a switch access program a switch interface will be required. There are a range of switch interfaces from wired to wireless which typically connect to the computer's USB port or are wirelessly connected via a Bluetooth connection.

Switch interface for PC

The JoyCable is an easy way to plug switches into a computer. The JoyCable plugs into the USB port and you can connect one or two switches, with standard (3.5mm) switch inputs. The JoyCable work with popular software such as The Grid 2, Clicker or Widgit software. Using the switch driver you can

Headmouse options


TrackIR 5

TrackIR is a head tracking input device designed for use with gaming and simulation PC titles. It is an infrared camera that tracks the position and orientation of your head, and then sends that data to the computer. A TrackClip with reflective markers is also required and is included with the TrackIR 5 purchase. It attaches to the brim of a hat or visor and has three retro-reflective markers that direct infrared light back to the camera.

Enable Viacam

Enable Viacam (eViacam) is a mouse replacement software that moves the pointer as you move your head.

It works on standard PC equipped with a webcam. No additional hardware is required. It's completely free, open source and easy to use!

Text to Speech programs

NaturalReader is a text to speech solution for personal, commercial, and educational use. It can convert text, PDF and various other formats into spoken audio so you can listen to your documents, eBooks, and school materials anytime. The free version of the software converts Microsoft Word files, webpages, PDF files, and emails into spoken words.

Text2Speech is a free program that converts text into audible speech. You can play the text at a custom rate and volume, have the text be highlighted as it's read. Text can also be exported into a WAV or an MP3 file.

Balabolka is a TTS program that allows you to read clipboard content and text from several types of files, such as DOC, EPUB, HTML, MOBI, LIT, CHM, PRC, PDF, and RTF files.

Claroread and Read&Write are both commercial products that provide text to speech and other further features.

Voice Control

The <u>VAC (Voice Activated Commands)</u> is software solution aimed to provide you with the means of controlling your applications or games just by speaking the commands, rather than typing them into your keyboard.

Use your voice to speak words or phrases to issue commands to your game.

Mainstream Games

Some games rely on speed of input, especially first-person shooters such as Call of Duty and the Battlefield series. However, some Roll Play Games are suitable for a wider range of gamers as they are less reliant on input speed as some other games. Here is a sample of old and new, that might be suitable.

No Man's Sky

This is a title, on release it got very bad press as it was perceived to have left out promised features and generally did not live up to the hype surrounding it. However, the company that makes it has recently released patch with a load of bug fixes and the first in what they say is a long line of new content for the game.



The game is a space-based exploration and resource gathering game. There can be some combat (which is where input speed is important), but that's not the focus of the game as a whole. It looks interesting, and the focus on exploration and gathering over combat means there's a lot do that won't require fast or accurate input, so those unable to react to situations quickly should still get as much out of the game as anyone else.

The new relaxed preset provides an accessible, laid-back experience of No Man's Sky. Perfect for players who want to experience all facets of gameplay, from story to survival to combat, with reduced danger and minimal grind.





Minecraft

An old favorite of the internet. As above, its focus is more on exploration, resource gathering and building. It's best described as a digital Lego box (and looks about the same). There's



no real requirement for input speed and accuracy is as much about placing blocks on each other so there's no time pressure.

All Minecraft games include an Accessibility menu that offers options to make the game more enjoyable for all players. The following options are available in all games.

Accessible menu navigation and narration provides options for navigation to include keyboard, touch, controller tools, and settings that provide audible narration while playing.

Speech to text provides an optional setting to communicate through voice in the game using dictation tools.

Chat text style formatting creates accessible options for players who want to experience chat in specific ways through text display (size, color, etc.).

Skyrim and Fallout 4

These are two RPG's by Bethesda. They are both big, open world games that players can explore while on a series of quests given by



various characters encountered in the game world. While there is a heavy focus on combat, it's not as fast or as "twitch" based as other games such as the shooters. In terms of content, both feature a fair amount of blood splatter (Skyrim more than Fallout), mostly to be seen after fights as an effect in the environment but Skyrim especially does have a few areas where one can encounter already bloodied areas (usually associated with a quest). Skyrim was originally released about 12 years ago but was re-released in ass Skyrim: Special Edition with updated graphics and lighting effects. Fallout 4 has been out about 8 years now.

This is an old series of games on the PC. They're unlikely to be available in shops, but the online service Steam should have them for sale. They're turn based games, so a player



effectively has an unlimited amount of time to make a move.

RTS games

Real Time Strategy games such as Star Craft may be worth considering. While they can get a little hectic at times, a lot of the gameplay relies on forward-planning and resource management. As such, input speed is less of a factor in gameplay. Planning and defense (which can quite often be automated) are more important in these games, and combat is always done by the AI. Player input is needed to assign targets, but after that, units can be left alone to perform their tasks. Most combat units will engage enemies automatically when encountered, so a player simply needs to send them to an area on the map rather than click a specific target (unless they want to).

Walking Simulators

This is a new genre of games that has sprung up over the past few years. It encapsulates a type of game that is generally 1st or 3rd person but contains no combat gameplay. The player is simply exploring a story through movement and interaction with the environment. Most famous are titles such as "Everyone's gone to the Rapture", "Dear Esther" and "The Stanley Parable". Due to the lack of combat, there's no pressure for input speed or accuracy. At points in the environment, players may have to press a button on a wall or solve a puzzle, but the lack of combat removes a lot of the problems with reaction time found in other games.

Xbox Accessibility

Gaming Accessibility is constantly improving, and Microsoft are strong leaders in this area. The availability on the Xbox OS of inbuilt features like Screen Reader, High Contrast, Speech to Text transcription and Magnification within the standard Xbox OS mean the platform is now much more accessible. This should bring more gamers with disabilities and drive demand for more inclusive games.

Xbox Adaptive Controller (XAC) And Compatible Accessories



When the Xbox Adaptive Controller came out in 2018 it represented a huge leap forward in the area of accessible gaming. The Xbox Adaptive Controller (XAC) allows ability switches (3.5mm jack) to replace any button on the standard controller. There are two USB inputs where (unfortunately) a rather limited selection of HID Joysticks can be plugged in. There is certainly room for improvement here as it was hoped that many more AT input devices would be supported (like the TrackerIR for example) but all in all

this is a great start and has put Microsoft and their Xbox platform at the forefront of accessible console gaming.

The photo above shows some input devices that can be connected to the Xbox through the Adaptive controller. Microsoft have a range of compatible joysticks and accessories that work with the adaptive controller available on their store (filter by selecting Assistive Technologies). They include one handed controllers, foot controllers (3DRudder, bottom left of the photo) and mouth joysticks with sip & puff (QuadSitck, bottom right of the photo). 

Sony have also been upgrading the accessibility of their PlayStation Platform in recent years. Vision support includes a Screen Reader, Zoom (Magnification), Invert colours, Colour filters. Physical access options allow users to control the sensitivity of buttons, intensity of haptic feedback as well as controller button remapping. Like Xbox, in-game accessibility needs to be designed by the developers and considered right from the start. On the <u>PlayStation Accessibility page</u> they highlight some games where special considerations to accessibility have been made.

An area Sony and PlayStation are doing well is promoting games that are more wholesome and promote well-being. <u>The PlayStation Guide to Wellbeing | This Month on PlayStation</u> lists some games that are more relaxing.

PS5 Access Controller

The PS5 Access Controller (links to Amazon.co.uk) brings Sony up to the same accessibility level as Microsoft Box. Launched in 2023 the PS5 Access Controller pictured below uses innovative design to bring a long awaited accessible controller option to PlayStation users.

Flex Controller

The Flex Controller (flex-controller.com) is an officially licenced adaptive controller developed by HORI, Japanese manufacturer for gaming devices, and supervised by





Technotools Corporation, Japanese manufacturer for assistive technology. It takes a similar approach to the XAC from Microsoft by supplying a switch input for each button on the Nintendo Switch (this has potential to get very confusing) and 2 USB inputs for external Joysticks. One of many potential setups of the Flex National Assistive Technology Training Service December 2024 Page 44

can be seen in the photograph below. In this case what looks like a wired Xbox controller and two switches are attached to the Nintendo Switch through the

Flex.

The Flex has two companion apps. The first is the configuration app, this allows you map buttons and configure joystick settings. The second app, called the Flex Controller Expansion App (FCEA). It allows you create onscreen buttons




and set different activation (dwell) times for each. With an additional piece of hardware called a video capture device you can play a docked Nintendo Switch completely independently using eye gaze. You can also use just the Flex and your eye gaze to play PC games.

Additional AT Hardware for Gaming

Even with the new accessibility features and hardware some gamers still require a bit more support. Below we have some additional options for using alternative input devices with game consoles.

Logitech Adaptive Gaming Kit

Launched a companion to the XAC, Logitech sell the Adaptive Gaming Kit (pictured above). This kit has twelve assorted switches with labels, Velcro, and other





mounting materials. Great for gaming (obviously) this kit would also be useful for all switch users and activities due to its value and versatility.

Eneso encore Switch Interface

Eneso enCore is a low-cost switch interface (about €60). What differentiates the encore from other switch interfaces is that it can be set up and recognised by computers and gaming consoles as a standard Keyboard or Mouse. This means it does not require a driver and once set up will be plug and play on all platforms. If a game accepts keyboard or mouse input using the encore and the Logitech Adaptive Gaming Kit an accessible bespoke controller could be configured.

The <u>Game Control Mixer</u> (GCM) is a powerful accessible gaming system that gives alternative input device users much more independence and versatility in their console setup. Compatible with Xbox, PlayStation, and Nintendo the GCM is a must have accessory for AT users who want to game on consoles. A wide range of input devices including switches, joysticks, joypads, speech and more can be mixed to form a single player controller. A special "SHIFT" switch enables players to reach more controls than they may be able to otherwise. The <u>Game Control Mixer</u> is sold and supported by OneSwitch.org.uk. <u>OneSwitch</u> is a wonderful place for gamers with additional needs to source some bespoke gaming technology. Barrie Ellis who runs the site is extremely helpful and a veritable mine of information about gaming accessibility. The <u>Game Controller Mixer</u> is a premium solution based on the <u>Titan One Adaptor</u>. Alongside the Microsoft XAC and some of the additional input options offered through <u>Celtic Magic</u> complete access to even the most challenging games can be achieved.

Celtic Magic Input Devices

<u>Celtic Magic</u> are a small UK electronics manufacturer who create innovative input devices for the use of people with disabilities around gaming and creativity. They along with OneSwitch designed the Game Control Mixer above. Some more of their devices include:

<u>Feather Joystick/Mouse</u>: Super sensitive light touch joystick (less than 5g of force needed to operate)

G-Click: Gyroscopic switch/sensor activated by tilting

<u>I-Click</u>: Infrared based proximity sensor for detecting muscle twitches and using them as input.

<u>Feather joystick</u>: joystick or mouse that uses magnetics rather than springs offering an adjustable world-beating sensitivity of less than five grams.

The complete <u>Bill of Materials</u>, <u>PCB Bord design and 3D files for printing the enclosure are all available on the AT Makers site here along with a construction guide</u>. If you need one of these, or you know someone who needs one, but you don't have the skills to construct one yourself, you should contact your local Maker Space (<u>like Tog in Dublin</u>). If you send them the link above, they may be able to direct you to someone who will put a freedom wing together.






