

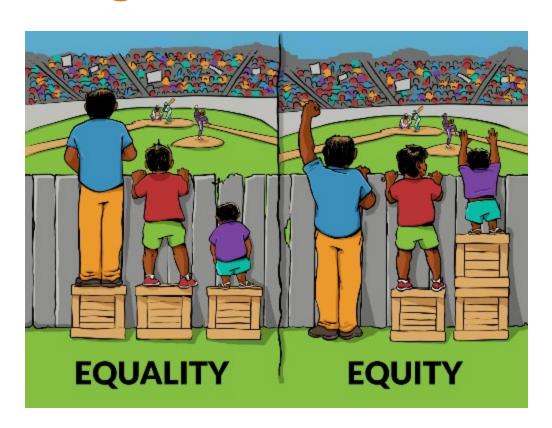

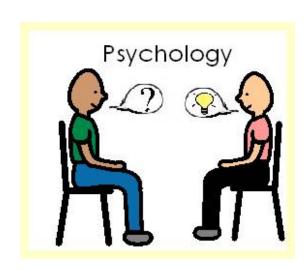

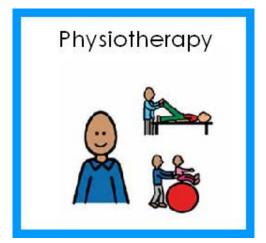

Family Centred Practice FCP

The CDNT follow a Family Centred Practice (FCP)
 Model of service delivery which is recommended
 nationally.

 Working together to support children and young people with complex needs.





Family Centred Practice - what is it?

- FCP means working in partnership with everyone involved with a child to achieve the best possible outcomes for the child and their family.
- Working with young children within their home, pre/school and community is believed to be the best way of working with children and their families. We call this 'best practice'.
- FCP is a way of working that has been researched with proven outcomes for children and families.

 Our focus is to build on and enhance the skills you already use as a family unit to support your child's development.

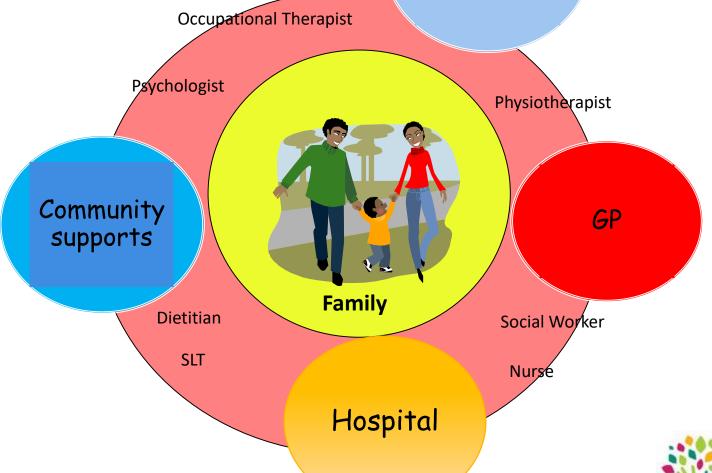

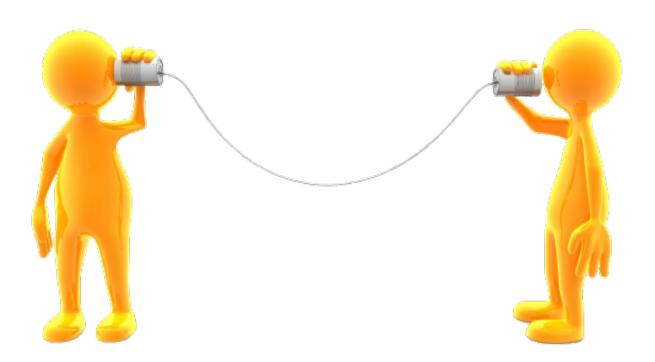

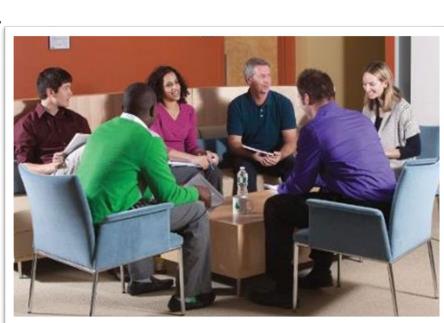






Individualised Family Support Plan (FSP)

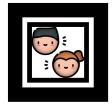

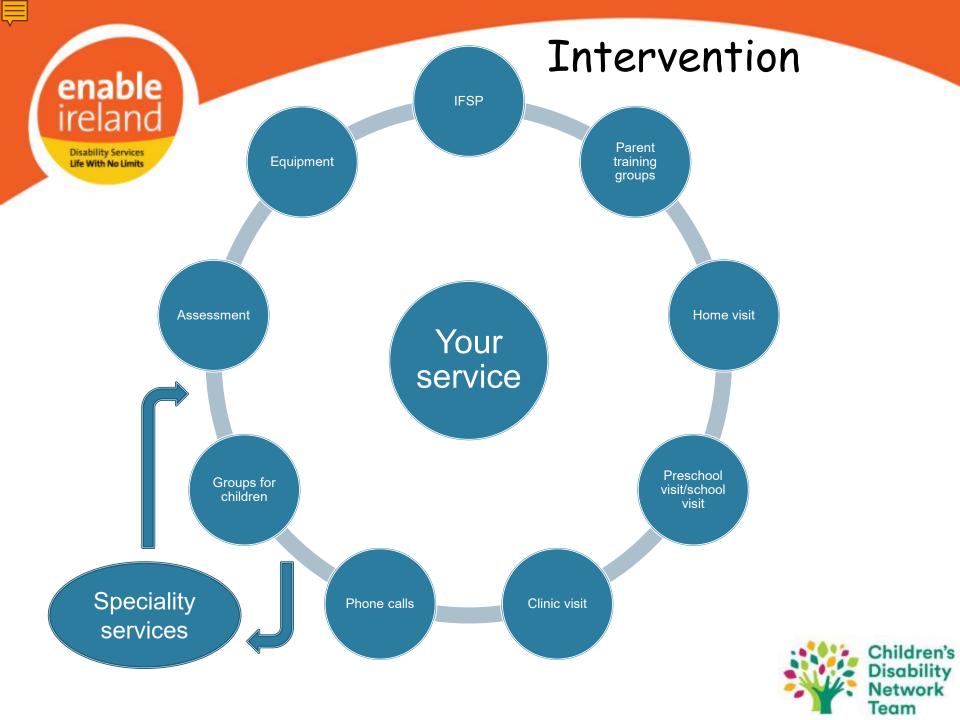
